Good morning one and all, a hearty and warm welcome to the dignitaries on the dais. It's a great pleasure to present the school annual report 2018-2019.

Objectives and Activities:

Objectives:

To advance for the public benefit, green education in particular, without prejudice, having a balanced curriculum under CBSE stream.

To promote, for the benefit of individuals, living in Andoor and the surrounding area, who have need by reason, to bring more professionals and learned community by being in green life.

Strategies:

Providing education which helps all pupils to achieve their full potential.

Encouraging respect for moral and spiritual values which reflect sustainable, green life style.

Helping all pupils grow into mature, self-disciplined citizens and leaders of green society.

We expect to achieve these aims in partnership with parents and teachers together with the community.

Activities 2018 – 2019

2013 – 2014 : Learning the anticipation of society in terms of expected outcome, providing learning with real time activities having 49 students.

2014 – 2015 : Implementation of concept learning with real time understanding so to apply the learned skill in everyday life with green practices. The languages also were given importance which gave way for learning the concepts. This target was aimed at having 143 students.

2015 – 2016 : Achievement in concept learning by identifying the student and setting target for each student reaching equality in learning among the students. The Olympiad exams conducted spoke all these where we got international concurrence. The students in total were 254.

2016 – 2017 & 2017 – 18 : Modulation of teaching methods considering the individuality of slow learners and special children, bringing further equality among the 306 children. Clubs were created to groom the children extra and co-curricular activities.

2018 – 2019: Vision for the current academic year is “Ease Concept Learning” through inclination, acquisition and intellection. Three long years drive has taken to a level of cent percentage implementation of study techniques so to enhance all the kids to be an expert in concepts. Now it goes as per the schedule we are with. This has been achieved by forming a trio of Teacher, a Tutor student and a slow learner in the class, ^{with a school total of 353}. A very good hike in performance could be found. By this the pace has been set which we wants to follow further so to not move off from the track. We feel this as a mile stone in our career. Also this year we footed out in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities which was silently going on in the last years, by participating in Kumari Kalai Kazhagam events and Rotary club events which are highly reputed in Kanyakumari district. Also we were with the science exhibition in Mar Ephrem Engineering College. In these nearly 115 students participated and 33 students got highest places.

2019 – 2020: Vision for the coming academic year is “Well roundedness” through inquisitiveness, innovation and resilient. This we have planned by having subject wise class in the morning session and activity oriented class in the afternoon session. The activities cover oratorical, and vocabulary skills in languages, experimentation skill in subjects leading to innovation. Adding to this spoken English without grammar mistake, is lacking in few classes that we wants to bring by next year as this gives ground for better presentation of the acquired or invented skills.

Olympiads

Nearly 140 students took part in Math, Science, English, GK, computer and space Olympiads. In this our children shot 40 gold medals, 26 silver medals and 25 bronze medals. Among them Shibi Mol of class III, Ashish Edin Baro of class IV, Glen R Cabrio of class IV and

Harshini of class V were selected for the second level exam and in this few results are yet to come. Adding to these Ashiqua of class III got a scholarship of Rs. 5000 from Indian Science Olympiad foundation.

Ascent Competitive Exam (ACE)

This is specifically conducted from KG onwards in General Awareness it gives ground for the higher level exam like Olympiads. Totally 118 students participated in this and ^{there} were 1 Ace scholar K. S. Akshay of class II, 2 ace stars A. Abina of L.K.G A, J. M. Jefri Monee of class I A, 10 ace masters R. Rinisha of L.K.G A, Aron Hanshik of L.K.G A, P. Vaigo of L. K.G B, A. Aruna of U.K.G A, Ashick Boshna of U.K.G B, P.Varsha of IA, L. Lanish of I B, Garyn R. Shine Brio of I B, S.
